Project Browser

- If we use the Project Browser effectively, we will be better and faster at Revit
- Use Project Browser <u>Search</u>



Keyboard Shortcuts

• If you are right-handed with the mouse, it makes sense to focus most of your shortcuts on your left hand.

• Further, you should try and set up 'single key' keyboard shortcuts if possible.

• You can also use the number keys like 0-9.



Keyboard Shortcuts

What about fast editing using 'Temporary' Visibility Graphics?

- Enable Temporary 8
- Visibility Graphics 9
- Restore 0

The Power of the Right-Click

- Browser toggle
- Recent Commands
- Create Similar



Better Workset Management

- Select All Instances
- Delete Workset
- Group then Change Workset



Faster Modelling with Built In Revit Tools

- Inherent selection after commands
- Splitting elements with Copy / Monitor



Faster Documentation with Built In Revit Tools

- Auto tag with Selection or Visibility controls
- Dimension entire walls, openings, intersecting walls
